by	the executive director that:
	(a) Congress has taken an action that will reduce the federal financial participation for
the	expansion population; and
	(b) the reduction in federal financial participation exceeds the reductions described in
<u>PP</u>	ACA, Subsection 2001(a)(3).
	Section 2. Repealer.
	This bill repeals:
	Section 26-18-18, Optional Medicaid expansion.
