17-25-6, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **17-25-6** is enacted to read:

17-25-6. Uniforms.

(1) A constable:

(a) shall:



28 (i) while performing a duty described in Section 17-25-1, wear a uniform shirt in
29 accordance with Subsection (2); and

30 (ii) purchase the uniform shirt; and

31 (b) may not use county or municipal funds to purchase the uniform shirt.

32 (2) (a) The legislative body of the appointing county or municipality described in
33 Section 17-25a-1 shall designate the uniform shirt described in Subsection (1)(a)(i); and

34 (b) the uniform shirt shall clearly identify:

35 (i) a person as a constable; and

36 (ii) the county or municipality for which the constable is employed.
