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**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill provides for funding for Advanced Placement test fees of low-income students.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ allows the State Board of Education to allocate money appropriated for the Enhancement for Accelerated Students Program for advanced placement test fees of **eligible** low-income students;
- ▶ appropriates money for the Enhancement for Accelerated Students Program; and
- ▶ provides intent language directing that money appropriated for the Enhancement for Accelerated Students Program be used for advanced placement test fees of **eligible** low-income students.

**Money Appropriated in this Bill:**

This bill appropriates in fiscal year 2015:

- ▶ to Related to Basic Programs - Related to Basic School Programs as an ongoing appropriation:
  - from the Education Fund, \$100,000.

**Other Special Clauses:**

This bill takes effect on July 1, 2015.

52 Section 2. **Appropriation.**

53 Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, for

54 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, and ending June 30, 2015, the following sums of money  
55 are appropriated from resources not otherwise appropriated, or reduced from amounts  
56 previously appropriated, out of the funds or accounts indicated. These sums of money are in  
57 addition to any amounts previously appropriated for fiscal year 2015.
