28 19-6-124. Incineration of medical waste. 29 (1) As used in this section, "medical waste" means: 30 (a) solid waste generated in the: 31 (i) diagnosis, treatment, or immunization of a human or animal; or 32 (ii) production or testing of a drug or vaccine; 33 (b) a culture or stock of an infectious agent; or 34 (c) a specimen from a medical, pathological, pharmaceutical, research, commercial, or 35 industrial laboratory. 36 (2) Except as provided in Subsection (3), the division may not approve an operation 37 plan or issue a permit for a facility that: (a) incinerates medical waste; and 38 39 (b) is located within a two-mile radius of a residential area. 40 (3) The division may renew an operation plan or renew a permit for a facility that does 41 not qualify under Subsection (2) if the facility is in operation on May 13, 2014.
