LONG TITLE

This bill enacts provisions of Title 58, Chapter 28, Veterinary Practice Act, related to teeth floating.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **58-28-607** is enacted to read:

58-28-607. Construction of chapter as it relates to teeth floating.

(1) As used in this section, "teeth floating" means the removal by a non-veterinary equine dental care provider of enamel points and the smoothing, contouring, or leveling of



28 dental arcades and incisors of equine or other farm animals, excluding a canine or feline.

29 (2) Nothing in this chapter may be construed to prohibit teeth floating.
