*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **72-4-221** is enacted to read:

**72-4-221. Jake Garn Legacy Highway.**

(1) There is established the Jake Garn Legacy Highway comprising a section of Route 40 from I-80 southerly to Route 32.



28            (2) The Department of Transportation shall designate the portions of the highway  
29 described in Subsection (1) as Jake Garn Legacy Highway on future state highway maps.

30            Section 2. Section **72-4-222** is enacted to read:

31            **72-4-222. Matheson Garn Rest ~~Ŝ→~~ Area ~~←Ŝ~~ .**

32            There is established the Matheson Garn Rest ~~Ŝ→~~ Area ~~←Ŝ~~ at milepoint 202.11 on  
32a Route 6 in  
33 Utah County.

34            Section 3. **Effective date.**

35            This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
