ENACTS:

72-4-221, Utah Code Annotated 1953

72-4-222, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **72-4-221** is enacted to read:

72-4-221 . Jake Garn Legacy Highway.

(1) There is established the Jake Garn Legacy Highway comprising a section of Route 40 from I-80 southerly to Route 32.

(2) The Department of Transportation shall designate the portions of the highway described in Subsection (1) as Jake Garn Legacy Highway on future state highway maps.

Section 2. Section **72-4-222** is enacted to read:

72-4-222 . Governor Scott Matheson and Senator Jake Garn Rest Area.

There is established the Governor Scott Matheson and Senator Jake Garn Rest Area

29 at milepoint 202.11 on Route 6 in Utah County.

30 Section 3. **Effective date.**

31 This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
