6	A BILL to direct the Department of Energy and the Department of Environmental Quality to analyze the
7	life cycle of renewable energy facilities; report.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The State Corporation Commission shall create a task force, in consultation with the Department
10	of Energy and the Department of Environmental Quality, to analyze the life cycle of renewable energy
11	facilities, including solar, wind, and battery storage components. The analysis shall assess the (i)
12	feasibility, costs, recycling and salvage opportunities, waste strategies, and liability for the
13	decommissioning of materials; (ii) potential impacts of underground infrastructure post-
14	decommissioning; and (iii) potential impacts of the life cycle on farming, forestry, and sensitive wetlands.
15	The task force shall include representatives of municipalities, the Virginia Solar Energy Development and
16	Energy Storage Authority, the Department of Energy, and the Department of Environmental Quality and
17	at least one representative for each of the following sectors: agriculture, forestry, regulated electric service
18	providers, competitive electric service providers, and rural utility consumer services cooperatives. The
19	State Corporation Commission shall submit a report of the task force's analysis to the Governor and the
20	Chairs of the House Committee on Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources and the Senate
21	Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Natural Resources no later than December 1, 2022.
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
