**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Tow truck drivers; prohibited acts.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits tow truck drivers from driving by the scene of a wrecked or disabled vehicle that is subject to a law-enforcement requested tow, initiating contact with the owner or operator of such vehicle by soliciting or offering towing services, and towing such vehicle.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Office of the Attorney General (OAG), the proposal may create additional work for OAG, and, therefore, may have a fiscal impact on agency operations. However, the fiscal impact cannot be quantified at this time.
