3. **Committee:** Courts of Justice

4. **Title:** Criminal justice training academies; curriculum.

5. **Summary:** Provides that an approved criminal justice training academy may utilize an alternative curriculum and lesson plans that meet or exceed the compulsory minimum training standards without seeking a waiver from the Department of Criminal Justice Services. Under current law, the Department is required to develop a uniform curriculum to be used at all criminal justice training academies unless a waiver to the uniform curriculum is granted by the Department.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** According to the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS), the proposed bill is not expected to create a fiscal impact on agency resources. The proposed bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on state or local law-enforcement agencies.
