3. **Committee:** Appropriations

4. **Title:** State parks; procurement exemption.

5. **Summary:** Exempts the Department of Conservation and Recreation for the purchase of items for resale at retail outlets and food services operations operated by state parks, provided that such procurement is accomplished in accordance with the provisions of subdivision G 1 of § 2.2-4303, Code of Virginia, and pursuant to a policy adopted by the Board of Conservation and Recreation.

7. **Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** By exempting certain items for resale at retail outlets and food services operations at state parks, the Department of Conservation and Recreation anticipates some cost savings; however, the total impact is unknown. Any savings would be utilized to support state park operations in other areas.
