3. **Committee:** Courts of Justice

4. **Title:** Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Program; fee.

5. **Summary:** Raises from \$300 to \$350 the maximum fee that may be charged to a person required by the court to enter the Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Program upon conviction of certain offenses related to driving a motor vehicle or commercial vehicle while intoxicated, operating a boat while intoxicated, or refusing to have samples of breath taken for chemical tests to determine alcohol content of blood.

8. **Fiscal Implications:** A reasonable portion of the fee, as may be determined by the Commission on VASAP, but not to exceed 10 percent, is forwarded monthly to be deposited with the State Treasurer for expenditure by the Commission on VASAP, and the balance is held in a separate fund for local administration of driver alcohol rehabilitation programs. According to the Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Program (VASAP), the potential fiscal impact of this proposal is indeterminate at this time.
