Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to (1) require the  
Commissioner of Buildings and General Services, on or before September 1,  
2023, to issue a request for proposal to study the feasibility of a State-owned  
public restroom open 24 hours a day and seven days a week in or near the  
Capitol Complex, and (2) submit a report on the results of the feasibility study  
to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and the Senate  
Committee on Institutions on or before October 15, 2024.

An act relating to studying the feasibility of a State-owned public restroom  
near the Capitol Complex

1 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

2 Sec. 1. STATE-OWNED PUBLIC RESTROOM; CAPITOL COMPLEX;

3 FEASIBILITY STUDY

4 (a) On or before September 1, 2023, the Commissioner of Buildings and  
5 General Services shall issue a request for proposal (RFP) to study the  
6 feasibility of constructing or installing a State-owned public restroom in or  
7 near the Capitol Complex, as defined by 29 V.S.A. § 182. The RFP shall  
8 require that the restroom is open to the public 24 hours a day and seven days a  
9 week.

10 (b) On or before October 15, 2024, the Commissioner of Buildings and  
11 General Services shall submit the results of the study described in subsection  
12 (a) of this section to the House Committee on Corrections and Institutions and  
13 the Senate Committee on Institutions.
