Subject: Internal security and public safety; prevention and investigation of fires; boilers and pressure vessels

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to allow a boiler or pressure vessel to be regulated using the European Committee for Standardization standard of up to 1,000,000 Btu.

An act relating to boilers and pressure vessels

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 20 V.S.A. § 2882 is amended to read:

§ 2882. RULES; INSTALLATION STANDARDS

* * *

(b) A boiler or pressure vessel regulated by the rules adopted under this section shall be designed, manufactured, and assembled in accordance with the relevant standards ~~published~~ adopted by the:

1 (1) American Society of Mechanical Engineers;

2 (2) Canadian Standards Association;

3 (3) European Committee for Standardization, for boilers with a
4 maximum water jacket size of 60 gallons, a maximum input of ~~250,000~~
5 1,000,000 Btu, and a maximum relief valve setting of 30 pounds per square
6 inch gauge; or

7 (4) European Committee for Standardization, for boilers or pressure
8 vessels with an input of greater than 250,000 Btu or a water jacket size of
9 greater than 60 gallons as approved by the commissioner.

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
