15	§ 5. BUSINESSES; PROMOTIONAL BEER AND WINE EXEMPTION
16	A business or nonprofit organization, including an art gallery or a chamber
17	of commerce, that is not the holder of a second class license, may serve
18	without a permit malt and vinous beverages free of charge by the individual
19	glass to a person for consumption on the premises at promotional events open
20	to the public, provided that the person is of legal age. A business shall not
