14	Sec. 1. AGENCY OF NATURAL RESOURCES' REPORT ON
15	DELEGATED CLEAN WATER ACT AUTHORITY
16	On or before January 15, 2012, the secretary of natural resources shall
17	report to the house committee on fish, wildlife and water resources, the senate
18	committee on natural resources and energy, and the house and senate
19	committees on appropriations regarding the economic costs and benefits of
20	forfeiting the authority delegated by the U.S. Environmental Protection

1	Agency to the agency of natural resources to implement and enforce the
2	federal Clean Water Act. The report shall include:
3	(1) A summary of when the agency of natural resources was delegated
4	federal Clean Water Act authority and how the agency implemented such
5	authority;
6	(2) A summary of the programs that the agency of natural resources
7	operates under delegated Clean Water Act authority;
8	(3) A summary of how environmental permitting is conducted in other
9	states that lack delegated Clean Water Act authority;
10	(4) A recommendation by the agency of delegated programs that the
11	state should forfeit authority to implement and enforce;
12	(5) An analysis of the environmental costs and benefits of forfeiting:
13	(A) all delegated authority; and
14	(B) delegated authority for the programs recommended by the agency
15	under subdivision (4) of this section.
16	(6) An analysis of the economic costs and benefits of forfeiting:
17	(A) all delegated authority; and
18	(B) delegated authority for the programs recommended by the agency
19	under subdivision (4) of this section.
20	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
21	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
