7 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the

8 holder of a commercial catering license to use the kitchen facilities of a first or

9 third class license holder.

10 An act relating to commercial catering licenses

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 2 is amended to read:

13 § 2. DEFINITIONS

14 The following words as used in this title, unless a contrary meaning is

15 required by the context, shall have the following meaning:

16 * * *

17 (33) "Commercial catering license": A license granted by the ~~board~~

18 Board permitting a business licensed by the ~~department of health~~ Department

19 of Health as a commercial caterer and having a commercial kitchen facility in

20 the home or place of business to sell malt, vinous, or spirituous liquors at a

1 function previously approved by the local licensing authority. The holder of a
2 commercial catering license may use a commercial kitchen facility located on
3 the premises of a first or third class licensee provided that the holder of the
4 commercial catering license does not serve alcoholic beverages on the
5 licensee's premises and that the caterer's inventory be stored separately from
6 the inventory of the licensee.

7 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

8 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
