Subject: Natural Resources; conservation; public access; State lands;
appropriation

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to conserve the
146-acre parcel in Benson and Orwell known as “Camp Sunrise” for ecological
purposes. The Secretary of Natural Resources shall negotiate in good faith
with the Boy Scouts Green Mountain Council to purchase “Camp Sunrise” and
to conserve the waters of Sunrise Lake and Sunset Lake to ensure ongoing
public access. This bill also proposes to appropriate the amount of
\$3,000,000.00 in general funds to the Agency of Natural Resources to use for
the purchase of the property, and any identified maintenance needed on the
property, to make it available for use by the public.
