Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: In order to address the concern that 50 percent of Vermont third-grade students are not meeting English Language Arts proficiencies and the overall low achievement and large achievement gaps for historically marginalized groups, this bill proposes to implement the recommendations of the Advisory Council on Literacy to build literacy skills in reading, writing, and communication, and an enjoyment of literacy by supporting and implementing best practices and evidence-based methods in reading instruction, assessment, and remediation.
