16	(a) Where an action is given to any appointed or elected municipal officer
17	OF, town school district officer, or any town resident who petitions town
18	government on a matter related to town business, the action shall be brought in

the name of the town in which the officer serves and, in the case of a town

school district officer in the name of the town school district, and in the case of

1	a town resident in the name of his or her town of residence. If the action is
2	given against such officers or resident, it shall be brought against such town or
3	town school district, as the case may be.
4	(b) The municipality shall assume all reasonable legal fees incurred by an
5	officer when the officer was acting in the performance of his or her duties and
6	did not act with any malicious intent.
7	(c) A town resident who petitions town government on a matter related to
8	town business against whom an action is given for that petition shall be
9	covered under the town's policy of liability insurance for that action.
10	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
11	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013.
