7	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to clarify that vehicles registered
8	out of state may obtain permits to use signal lamps and sirens in Vermont.

11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1252 is amended to read:
13	§ 1252. USES OF SIRENS OR COLORED LAMPS OR BOTH
14	(a) When satisfied as to the condition and use of the vehicle and that the
15	vehicle is properly registered in Vermont or its home state or province, the
16	commissioner shall issue and may revoke, for cause, permits for sirens or
17	colored signal lamps in the following manner:
18	(1) Sirens or blue or blue and white signal lamps, or a combination of
19	these, for all law enforcement vehicles, owned or leased by a law enforcement
20	agency or a certified law enforcement officer and if the applicant is a

constable, the application shall be accompanied by a certification by the town
clerk that the applicant is the duly elected or appointed constable and attesting
that the town has not voted to limit the constable's authority to engage in
enforcement activities under 24 V.S.A. § 1936a.

(2) Sirens and red or red and white signal lamps for all ambulances; vehicles with fire apparatus; vehicles owned or leased by, or provided to volunteer firemen and voluntary rescue squad members, including a vehicle vehicles owned by a volunteer's employer when the volunteer has the written authorization of the employer to use the vehicle for emergency fire or rescue activities; and motor vehicles used solely in rescue operations.

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
