Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to limit the
hours during which a person may transport a catalytic converter.

An act relating to limiting the transport of catalytic converters

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 9 V.S.A. § 3022a is added to read:

§ 3022a. CATALYTIC CONVERTERS

(a) A person shall not transport a catalytic converter in this State between
the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.

(b) A person who transports a used catalytic converter between the hours of
8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. shall possess a bill of sale for the catalytic converter,

1 signed by the seller, that includes the VIN number of the vehicle from which it
2 was removed.

3 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

4 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
