7	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the
8	Vermont income tax exemption for Social Security benefits by exempting
9	50 percent of all federally taxable Social Security benefits, regardless of a
10	taxpayer's adjusted gross income. Taxpayers whose adjusted gross income
11	currently qualifies for a full exemption of their benefits will continue to be
12	fully exempt. For taxpayers whose adjusted gross income is above the limit
13	for a full exemption, the remaining 50 percent of federally taxable Social
14	Security benefits will be excluded from taxable income according to the
15	existing phase-out schedule.
