15	more than 60 days, or both. Upon a second and all subsequent convictions, the
16	violator shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00 nor less than \$500.00 or

imprisoned for not more than 60 days, or both.

(b) Subsection (a) of this section shall apply to taking deer out of season,

with the exception that upon a second and all subsequent convictions, the
