9 An act relating to recognizing the rescue dog as the State Dog

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 1 V.S.A. § 517 is added to read:

12 § 517. STATE DOG

13 The State Dog is the rescue dog, defined as any dog adopted from an animal
14 shelter, a duly incorporated humane society, or a rescue organization.

15 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

16 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2015.
