12	(a) Upon receiving a divorce complaint, the Court shall refer the parties to
13	the Vermont Superior Court Family Mediation Program.
14	(b) A party may file a motion with the Court seeking an exemption from
15	mediation in cases where there a high degree of conflict or a court has issued
16	an abuse prevention order or an order against stalking or sexual assault
17	concerning the parties to the divorce. The Court may grant the exemption or
18	require the parties to participate in mediation under certain conditions.
19	(c) The mediator shall report to the Court if he or she deems the parties
20	unwilling participants in the mediation.

1	(d) The number of mediation sessions may be determined on an individual
2	basis by the mediator, but shall not exceed six sessions without approval of the
3	<u>Court.</u>
4	(e) The costs of mediation shall be paid by the Judiciary.
5	(f) The Judiciary shall promulgate rules to implement this section.
