| 14 | As used in In this chapter;:  |
| 15 | (1) "Amusement ride" means a mechanical device which carries or                 |
| 16 | conveys passengers along, around, or over a fixed or restricted route or course |
| 17 | for the purpose of giving the passengers amusement, pleasure, thrills, or       |
| 18 | excitement. In addition, for the purposes of this chapter, amusement ride shall |
| 19 | also include bungee jumping, but does not include:                              |

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| 1  | (A) Any single-passenger coin-operated ride that is manually.                      |
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| 2  | mechanically, or electrically operated and customarily placed in a public          |
| 3  | location and that does not normally require the supervision or services of an      |
| 4  | operator;  |
| 5  | (B) Nonmechanized playground equipment, including swings,                          |
| 6  | seesaws, stationary spring-mounted animal features, rider-propelled                |
| 7  | merry-go-rounds, climbers, slides, trampolines, and inflatable bouncers; or        |
| 8  | (C) Physical fitness devices or ski lifts and tramways that are not part           |
| 9  | of a carnival or fair.   |
| 10 | (2) "Operator" or "owner" means a person who owns or controls or has               |
| 11 | the duty to control the operation of amusement rides.                              |
| 12 | (3) "Certificate" or "certificate of operation" means a document issued            |
| 13 | by the secretary of state authorizing the operation of one or more amusement       |
| 14 | rides, indicating thereon the following information for each amusement ride:       |
| 15 | an insurer with whom the operator or owner has contracted or an agent of the       |
| 16 | insurer attesting that one or more amusement rides passed the most recent          |
| 17 | inspection required by this chapter. The certificate shall include for each        |
| 18 | amusement ride the proper ride model, serial number and passenger capacity of      |
| 19 | the ride, the recommended maximum speed of the ride, and recommended               |
| 20 | direction of travel of the ride. The secretary of state may amend a certificate to |
| 21 | add other amusement rides to be operated in the state during a calendar year.      |

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| 2  | of not less than \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence, insuring the owner or operator    |
| 3  | against liability for injury to persons arising out of the use of the amusement   |
| 4  | <u>ride.</u>  |
| 5  | (3) Is identified by an inspection certificate and insurance policy, or           |
| 6  | photocopies of these documents as authorized by the secretary, filed with the     |
| 7  | agency of agriculture, food and markets in the manner required by this chapter.   |

| 10 | The documents required by section 723 of this title shall be filed annually       |
| 11 | with the secretary before June 1, but if the amusement ride is inspected under    |
| 12 | subsection 723(c) more than once a year, the inspection certificate shall be      |
| 13 | filed not later than 15 days after each inspection and the insurance policy shall |
| 14 | be filed annually before June 1.  |

| 17 | The secretary may request from any person responsible for an amusement            |

| 20 | ride. The person to whom the information request is made shall respond to the     |
| 21 | secretary within 15 days of the request.  |
