16	composing or sending of electronic communications, including text messages,		

instant messages, or e-mails, using a portable electronic device as defined in

subdivision 4(82) of this title, but shall not be construed to include use of a

global positioning or navigation system.

1	(b) A person shall not engage in texting while operating a moving motor			
2	vehicle on a highway.			
3	(c) A person who violates this section commits a traffic violation as defined			
4	in section 2302 of this title and shall be subject to a penalty of \$100.00 not less			
5	than \$250.00 upon adjudication of a first violation and \$250.00 of not less than			
6	\$500.00 upon adjudication of a second or subsequent violation within any			
7	two-year period.
