Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
seller of a building to disclose, at the time of sale, any available documentation
of the building's compliance with the Residential Building Energy Standards
or Commercial Building Energy Standards, as applicable. It would require the
seller to disclose any energy assessment reports conducted on the building in
the last five years.
