8	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to create and
9	link a suite of initiatives designed to encourage knowledge-based business
10	ventures in Vermont by cultivating and supporting networks of entrepreneurs,
11	innovators, educators, and investors, by reaching out to new communities of
12	knowledge workers within and beyond Vermont, and by enabling opportunities
13	for new participants in the knowledge-based economy; to incentivize the
14	creation and growth of new knowledge-based businesses domiciled in Vermont
15	by removing administrative and financial barriers, by increasing government
16	accessibility, and streamlining regulatory processes, by supporting creative
17	spaces and the creative process, and by expanding opportunities to incubate
18	new business concepts through the structured and unstructured exchange of
19	ideas and experiences; to reward successful start-ups and their investors by

allowing investment returns that adequately reflect the risk and imagination

required in technology- and innovation-based capital; and to protect

1	intellectual property by enhancing legal protections and expanding remedies
2	available to innovators for safeguarding their ideas.
