Subject: Motor vehicles; town highways; cut-through traffic

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize the legislative body of a municipality to restrict and regulate cut-through traffic on class 3 and 4 town highways located entirely within the municipality.

An act relating to regulating cut-through traffic on class 3 and 4 town highways

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1008 is amended to read:

§ 1008. REGULATIONS IN MUNICIPALITIES

* * *

(c)(1) As used in this subsection, “cut-through traffic” means vehicular traffic passing through an area without having an origin or destination within the area.

(2) The legislative body of a municipality may make special regulations to restrict, prohibit, or otherwise regulate cut-through traffic on class 3 and class 4 town highways located entirely within the municipality. The legislative

1 body may authorize that barriers be erected pursuant to such regulations. Signs
2 indicating the special regulations must be conspicuously posted in and near all
3 areas affected.

4 (d) Municipal motor vehicle regulations shall not duplicate or contradict
5 any provision of this title.

7 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
