Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to establish a  
maximum speed limit of not more than 55 miles per hour on all limited access  
and controlled access highways in Vermont, which includes all highways in  
the State that are on the Dwight D. Eisenhower National System of Interstate  
and Defense Highways, as a means of reducing the use of fossil fuel and  
greenhouse gas emissions.
