13	(a) Health insurers shall provide coverage for inpatient care in connection
14	with a mastectomy, lymph node dissection, or breast conserving surgery for at
15	least 48 hours following the surgery or procedure, or longer if the patient's
16	attending physician determines that a longer stay is medically necessary.
17	(b) As used in this subchapter, "health insurer" means insurance companies
18	that provide health insurance as defined in subdivision 3301(a)(2) of this title,

nonprofit hospital and medical services corporations, and health maintenance

1	organizations. The term does not apply to coverage for specified disease or
2	other limited benefit coverage.
3	Sec. 2. APPLICABILITY AND EFFECTIVE DATE
4	This act shall take effect on October 1, 2010, and shall apply to all health
5	benefit plans on and after October 1, 2010, on such date as a health insurer
5	offers, issues, or renews the health benefit plan, but in no event later than
7	October 1, 2011.
