- (b) Parties may not request claims for relief other than money damages
 under this chapter. Nor may parties split a claim in excess of \$5,000.00

 - (c) In small claims actions where the plaintiff makes a claim for relief greater than \$3,500.00, the defendant shall have the right to request a special assignment of a judicial officer. Upon making this request, a superior Superior judge or a member of the Vermont bar Bar appointed pursuant to 4 V.S.A. \$ 22(b) shall be assigned to hear the action.
