Subject: Insurance; homeowners; weather events; availability; rates; study

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
Commissioner of Financial Regulation to monitor the homeowners insurance  
market in Vermont to determine whether weather events such as flooding have  
led to increased rates or decreased availability of such insurance and, if so,  
whether establishment of a joint underwriting association is necessary to  
protect homeowners from a limited or nonextant voluntary market in all or  
parts of the State.
