Subject: Health; public health; COVID-19; masks; rapid antigen tests

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
Department of Health to develop and implement a plan to disseminate masks
and at-home rapid antigen tests recommended by the U.S. Centers for Disease
Control and Prevention or other qualified public health institution throughout
the State directly to consumers free of charge. Masks disseminated pursuant to
this act shall be either N95, KN95, or masks of the same quality and
effectiveness as N95 and KN95 masks.
