Subject: Motor vehicles; operator’s licenses; suspensions; reinstatement;
driving under the influence

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend or
modify the requirements for operator’s license reinstatement, including
following a conviction of driving under the influence, so as to eliminate or
minimize financial barriers; ensure that reinstatement requirements, such as
completion of the Impaired Driving Rehabilitation Program (IDRP), are
targeted to a conviction for driving under the influence and can be completed
in a timely manner prior to reinstatement; and, as appropriate, increase use of
Ignition Interlock Devices (IIDs) and participation in the Total Abstinence
Program.
