Subject: Conservation and development; taxation; use value appraisal; reserve
forestland

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to amend the requirements for enrolling reserve forestland in the Use Value Appraisal Program. The bill would reduce from 50 percent to 25 percent the amount of reserve forestland that must be composed of significant and sensitive conditions on parcels of up to 100 acres. Similarly, the bill would reduce from 30 percent to 15 percent the amount of reserve forestland that must be composed of significant and sensitive conditions on parcels of 100 acres or more.
