Sec. 2. DIVISION OF CHITTENDEN-6

In addition to the division requirements of 17 V.S.A. § 1906c, Chittenden-6, as set forth in Sec. 1 of this act, shall be divided to include a two-member district comprising the entire city of Winooski and additional sufficient population from the city of Burlington to satisfy equal representation requirements.

Sec. 3. DIVISION OF INITIAL DISTRICTS

Notwithstanding the date set forth in 17 V.S.A. §§ 1906b and 1906c by which boards of civil authority must submit to the clerk of the house any

proposal for the division of initial districts, the boards of civil authority shall submit these proposals to the clerk by March 15, 2012.

Sec. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
