5 Subject: Taxation; government operations; property appraisals; appeals;

7 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to reimburse unified towns and gores

8 for the expenses they incurred in conducting grievance hearings in compliance

9 with 32 V.S.A. § 4408 between July 1, 2009 and February 23, 2011.

10 An act relating to reimbursing unified towns and gores for expenses
11 incurred in conducting grievance hearings

12 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

13 Sec. 1. REIMBURSEMENT FOR GRIEVANCE HEARING

14 EXPENDITURES

15 (a) A unified town or gore shall be entitled to claim reimbursement for
16 expenditures incurred in conducting grievance hearings when:

17 (1) the hearing was held between July 1, 2009 and February 23, 2011;

18 (2) the expenditures related to hiring a person or persons to participate
19 in the grievance hearing; and

20 (3) the expenditures were necessary to comply with 32 V.S.A. § 4408.

1 (b) Claims shall be filed with the department of taxes within 60 days of the
2 effective date of this act, with receipts or other documentation as the
3 department may require.

4 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

5 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2012.
