13 Subject: Education; elementary education; secondary education; school choice

14 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to create a voucher program to enable
15 Vermont elementary and secondary students to attend any public or approved
16 independent school in the state. It would also grant school districts the
17 discretion to pay tuition for a resident student to attend an out-of-state school,
18 provided the district's payment did not exceed the base education amount for
19 the year of enrollment.
