Subject: Education; student enrollment; property taxes

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow natural persons who own nonhomestead property in a municipality to enroll their child in a public school in the municipality even though the property owned is not their homestead. For a nonhomestead owner, in order to enroll the owner's child in a public school in that municipality, the owner would have to own not less than one acre of undeveloped land in the municipality and pay either the nonhomestead property tax rate for the undeveloped land or an amount equal to the average homestead tax bill in that municipality, whichever is higher.

An act relating to the right to enroll a child in a public school where the property owned by the child's parent or guardian in the municipality is not their homestead

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
