12	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to define the term "farmers' market"
13	and to authorize the Vermont Farmers' Market Association to develop
14	minimum standards and best practices for farmers' market operations in this
15	state seeking to become members of the Vermont Farmers' Market
16	Association.
17	An act relating to farmers' markets

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

1	Sec. 1. 6 V.S.A. chapter 216 is added to read:
2	CHAPTER 216. FARMERS' MARKETS
3	§ 5001. DEFINITION
4	In this chapter, "farmers' market" shall mean an event or series of events at
5	which two or more vendors of agricultural products, as defined in 11 V.S.A.
6	§ 991, gather for purposes of offering for sale to the public their agricultural
7	products.
8	§ 5002. VERMONT FARMERS' MARKET ASSOCIATION
9	<u>MEMBERSHIP</u>
10	(a) Farmers' markets in this state that meet the minimum standards and best
11	practices set forth in subsection (b) of this section may become members of the
12	Vermont Farmers' Market Association.
13	(b) The Vermont Farmers' Market Association shall:
14	(1) develop minimum standards and best practices for the management
15	and use of farmers' markets in this state, together with and subject to the
16	approval of the agency of agriculture, food and markets; and
17	(2) extend memberships to farmers' markets that meet the standards and
18	best practices established under subdivision (1) of this subsection.
19	Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE
20	This act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
