Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require a  
municipality to treat a substance abuse recovery home as a single-family  
residential home under its land use bylaws.

An act relating to regulation of substance abuse recovery homes under local  
land use bylaws

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 24 V.S.A. § 4412 is amended to read:

§ 4412. REQUIRED PROVISIONS AND PROHIBITED EFFECTS

Notwithstanding any existing bylaw, the following land development  
provisions shall apply in every municipality:
