17	adjusted under section 5402b of this chapter; and shall be subject to the
18	homestead education property tax at three-quarters of the base rate provided in
19	subdivision (a)(2) of this section, as adjusted under section 5402b of this
20	chapter, and multiplied by its district spending adjustment.
