Subject: Motor vehicles; Department of Motor Vehicles; license plates;
specialty plates; veterans

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the
Department of Motor Vehicles, in consultation with the Office of Veterans'
Affairs and other interested stakeholders, to review the specialty plates that are
currently available for veterans in Vermont and determine if any currently
offered specialty plates should be retired and if any new specialty plates should
be offered, such as branch of service or combat service, with consideration
paid to, at a minimum, the current number of each specialty plate issued by the
Department, the overall cost of the specialty plate program, and the cost to
produce and make available a new specialty plate. This bill also proposes to
require that the Department file a written report on the results of its review and
any recommended changes to statute to the House and Senate Committees on
Transportation, the House Committee on Government Operations and Military

1 Affairs, and the Senate Committee on Economic Development, Housing and
2 General Affairs.
