

**No. R-382. House concurrent resolution congratulating the 2016 Lyndon Institute Vikings Division II boys' indoor track and field championship team.**

Whereas, indoor track and field features runners maximizing their speed at distances ranging from 55 meters to 3,200 meters, surmounting hurdles placed along a 55-meter course, and as members of four-person relay teams, and

Whereas, different athletic strengths are challenged in the high, long, and triple jumps; the pole vault; shot put; and weight throw, and

Whereas, at the 2016 indoor track and field championship held at Norwich University, the Lyndon Institute Vikings dominated the boys' Division II competition, earning 130 points, nearly double that of second-place Oxbow's 67 points, and winning Lyndon's first track title since 2002, and

Whereas, the Viking boys, who placed the team's success above their individual accomplishments, were John Abbott, Rory Bean, John Burrows, Travis Ferguson, Zachary Legge, Ricardo McPhee, Brian Ntabana, and Ashton Rodriguez, and

Whereas, Head Coach Jack Harris and Assistant Coach Kevin Hickey were great supporters of the boys' efforts, and everyone associated with the team appreciated the support of manager Capri Colby, now therefore be it
