Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require at least one member of the Green Mountain Care Board to be a health care professional.

An act relating to requiring at least one member of the Green Mountain Care Board to be a health care professional

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 9374 is amended to read:

§ 9374. BOARD MEMBERSHIP; AUTHORITY

(a)(1) On July 1, 2011, the Green Mountain Care Board is created and shall consist of a chair and four members. The Chair and all of the members shall be State employees and shall be exempt from the State classified system. The Chair shall receive compensation equal to that of a Superior judge, and the compensation for the remaining members shall be two-thirds of the amount received by the Chair.

4 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

5 This act shall take effect on passage and shall apply beginning with the first
6 vacancy occurring on the Green Mountain Care Board on or after that date;
7 provided, however, that it shall not be construed to disqualify a non-health care
8 professional member serving on the Board on the date of passage of this act
9 from being reappointed after the date of passage to serve one or more
10 additional terms.
