5 Subject: Professions and occupations; estheticians; nonablative lasers

6 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to authorize licensed estheticians to
7 use nonablative lasers.

8 An act relating to the use of nonablative lasers by licensed estheticians

9 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

10 Sec. 1. 26 V.S.A. § 273 is amended to read:

11 § 273. EXEMPTIONS

12 The provisions of this chapter regulating barbers and cosmetologists shall
13 not:

14 * * *

15 (5) affect or prevent the practice of barbering or cosmetology outside a
16 registered shop or school by licensees in accordance with rules adopted by the
17 board;

18 (6) prohibit the use of nonablative lasers by a licensed esthetician.

19 “Nonablative laser” means a laser that does not penetrate the stratum corneum,
20 or the outermost layer of the skin.
