10	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
11	Sec. 1. PURPOSE; INTENT
12	(a) The purpose of this act is to require the State Ethics Commission to
13	propose to the General Assembly a State Code of Ethics that would be
14	enforced by the Commission.
15	(b) The General Assembly intends to consider the Commission's proposal
16	and enact into law an enforceable Code during the 2021–2022 biennium.
17	Sec. 2. STATE ETHICS COMMISSION; PROPOSAL
18	On or before November 15, 2020, the State Ethics Commission shall submit
19	to the Senate and House Committees on Government Operations a proposed
20	State Code of Ethics that would apply to the Executive Branch and to the

1	Legislative Branch for non-core legislative duties and that would be enforced
2	by the Commission.

5	SURCHARGE; REPEAL
6	(a) Surcharge.
7	(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of 3 V.S.A. § 2283(c) setting forth
8	the purpose and rate of charges collected in the Human Resource Services
9	Internal Service Fund, in fiscal year 2018 and thereafter, a surcharge of up to
10	2.3 percent, but no greater than the cost of the activities of the State Ethics
11	Commission set forth in Sec. 7 of this act, on the per-position portion of the
12	charges authorized in 3 V.S.A. § 2283(c)(2) shall be assessed to all Executive
13	Branch agencies, departments, and offices and shall be paid by all assessed
14	entities solely with State funds.
15	(2) The amount collected shall be accounted for within the Human
16	Resource Services Internal Service Fund and used solely for the purposes of
17	funding the activities of the State Ethics Commission set forth in Sec. 7 of

19	(b) Repeal. This section shall be repealed on June 30, 2020 July 1, 2021.
